18th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

God invites us to share in the only life which fully satisfies all our human longings – his own. The banquet which he spreads before us is ours to enjoy or reject, we are told in the first reading. It is God’s free gift, which we do not deserve and cannot earn. But his covenant of love, enjoyed even now, will endure forever if we accept his invitation and come to the banquet. In the gospel, Jesus leaves his retreat to minister to people who hunger for his word and long for his healing. He refuses to let his disciples send these needy ones away. By his own example he shows his followers how they are to carry on his ministry in the church. Jesus’ blessing of the bread anticipates the Eucharistic feast, when the bread of life will be given to all who hunger for it. St. Paul reminds us of another side of Christian life: the follower of Christ must share the suffering of the Master. This can be a blessing which brings us closer to Christ and makes us better able to enjoy the feast our creator spreads before us.

Where is God to be found? Elijah experienced God’s presence, not in signs of power but in the sound of silence and a gentle breeze. Before the prophet was sent out on his mission, he listened to God in the silence. But we can also find God in the storms that batter our lives. Jesus is the calming influence in the midst of a stormy

Sea of Galilee. He had been praying alone; when he goes to rejoin his disciples, their fear is the typical human reaction to God’s manifestation. The boat tossed about in the night is an image of the Church enduring the darkness of faith. Impetuously, Peter wants to be reunited immediately with Jesus, and asks to join him; but his faith is fragile. His cry to Jesus is what every Christian must learn to pray. We know Christ to be Lord when he saves us. St. Paul tells of his own consuming love for those who should recognize God’s Son and do not. If we have met God, we too will be apostles burning with love for those who do not recognize Jesus as Lord.
