15th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - B



Today's readings speak of vocation. In the first, Amos tells how God called him from his work as shepherd to become a prophet. Since prophets trouble our consciences,

we would prefer that prophesied elsewhere; one of the priests at the national shrine had ordered Amos to leave. The gospel tells of the mission Jesus gives to the Twelve to preach, to exorcise, and to heal. They are the first Christian missionaries, and they must travel light, relying on God and accepting the hospitality which is offered them. Preaching the gospel is a heavy responsibility, and its preachers must be willing to do without whatever deflects them from their purpose. Jesus warns that they will not be welcome everywhere. The letter to the Ephesians gives thanks for our vocation as God's adopted sons and daughters. We have been won by Christ's blood, freed from sin, and introduced into the mystery of God's plan. Every Christian has the vocation to bless and praise God and to give our Father glory!

16th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - B

People are hungry for the saving word of God! In Mark's gospel it is the crowds who are quicker than Jesus' disciples or relatives to understand him. The disciples had just served their apprenticeship as apostles, *those who are sent*. They are tired after their first experience of ministry, and Jesus suggested that they rest. But their Master's concern for his new co-workers soon gave way to compassion for the shepherd-less crowd! For Jesus – as for those who carry on his ministry – service to others must take precedence over personal comfort. In the first reading, God threatens the careless pastors of his people, promising to send good shepherds and, finally, the messiah who will be both shepherd and ruler. The letter to the Ephesians reminds us that Christ is the principle of unity in a world torn by enmities. As his followers, we must not be intolerant or retreat into a ghetto Christianity. Jesus brings what the world is longing for, peace and unity. We are the apostles of the one who unites. Through Jesus in the Spirit all people will come to the Father.



16th Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 18, 2021

When the apostles were trying to reflect on their ministry, Jesus asked them to "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while." Listening to God in quiet prayer is very important in vocation discernment. Listen to God's voice in an out of the way place. If you feel the call is genuine or call **Rev. Fr.
