17th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - B

Jesus' miracles are signs revealing who he is for us. In John, the multiplication of loaves forms the basis for Jesus' teaching about himself as the bread of life, which we must accept for



our nourishment or reject for our death. The gospels of the next four Sundays will reflect on the meaning of this sign. In John's telling, Jesus is alone, followed by a large crowd. He is concerned to feed all these people, and he questions the disciples: Where will they obtain food for so many? Then, with a blessing similar to that of the Eucharist, Jesus alone distributes the few loaves and fish to the crowd until they are filled. In their enthusiasm – they hope for an easy life without labor – they recognize Jesus as the messiah but misunderstand the sign. Jesus has to escape; again he is alone. Today's first reading gives an Old Testament example of how God provides beyond all expectation. Ephesians exhorts us, who share so much in common, to live in loving unity. Above all, Christ feeds us with one spiritual food, the Eucharist.



18th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - B



Why do we seek Jesus? Is it for the wrong reason, to satisfy material or egoistic needs? Like the crowd in the gospels, are we looking for still more signs and proofs? This crowd did not understand that the gift of manna

to the chosen people starving in the wilderness (see today's first reading) educated them to trust in God and to appreciate everything as God's gift. In the gospel, Jesus presents himself as God's message, the bread from heaven, which sustains us for eternal life. Indeed, he is even more than that, as we see when he offers us an immediate relationship with him. But we must accept him on his own terms. Jesus' reply to the crowd's request for food is phrased in the style of God's self-disclosure in the Old Testament, I am. Not only are we to believe in Jesus, we must enter into living communion with the bread of life. The letter to the Ephesians urges us to a revolutionary change of lifestyle. We will become new people if we accept Jesus' accept Jesus' invitation and make him central in our lives.
