Today's gospel contrasts counterfeit devotion with true generosity. Jesus warns about those who exploit their position of religious leadership. To gain church prestige by conspicuous

dress, or to seek deferential greetings or honored seats, is hypocrisy. Lengthy prayers cannot make amends for exploitation of the helpless. Jesus, whose ministry was supported by the contributions of women, noticed that the rich gave to God only from their surplus, while a poor widow contributed everything she had. Her offering was the more noteworthy because widows at that time were exceptionally vulnerable – they did not inherit their husband's estate. In the first reading, another poor widow, a pagan, shares with God's prophet the last morsel of food she has for herself and her son. God is not outdone in generosity, and her food supply lasts until the famine ends. The generosity of these two widows is like God's generosity in giving everything he had, Jesus; Jesus in turn showed us what God is like by offering himself for our sins. He continues to pray for us in God's presence!

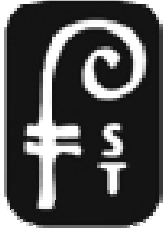
School Mass for November

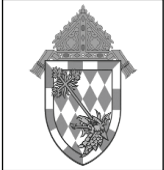
THE SHEPHERDS' TRUST COLLECTION

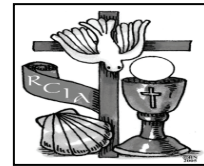
First Holy Communion 2021-2022
